CALLING ALL HOMEMAKERS

 Swimming Safety
 Emphasized

Hot weather is here and families are once again heading for lakes and rivers to engage in water sports. These can be fun times, yet they can quickly turn into a tragedy.

Water sports provide excellent recreation, but safety must be foremost in the minds of everyone engaged in such activities.

Accidents involving children thousands of lives over the United States each year. Last year about 600 Texans lost their lives in water-related accidents, with most of the deaths occurring during the summer months.

Some safety tips on swimming to make those outdoor outings in your favorite lake both fun-filled and safe:

1. First of all, all non-swimmers should enroll in a swimming course. Check with your local Red Cross, YMCA or YWCA, or other community groups that may be conducting such courses.

2. Never swim alone and know the area in which you are swimming. Even a strong swimmer can be undone by strange currents, tides or sudden dropoffs.

3. Supervise small children constantly.

4. Don't swim if chilled, overheated or overfed, or if a thunderstorm threatens.

5. If a person near you is in danger of drowning, don't jump in after him unless you are trained in lifesaving. Instead, extend a pole, life buoy or anything that will float.

Survivors have shown that almost half the drowning victims in the United States last year were reluctant swimmers. That fact in itself should serve to make people more cautious around water.

Hay Producers Should Plan For October Show

 Hay making time is at hand and producers in Colorado County are harvesting a good quality crop. While in the process of cutting and harvesting hay, producers should think about the upcoming County Hay Show as well as the State Hay Show this fall.

Hay shows are designed to be educational and provide producers an opportunity to view top quality hay. It is important that producers know all the key elements that go into top quality hay and are familiar with hay judging procedures.

The Colorado County Hay Show is set for early October at Columbus. All entries should be submitted to the County Extension office by early September.

Entries from throughout Texas are expected at the 1976 State Hay Show to be held October 2 at the Hanes Green Farm east of Austin on Farm Road 973. In addition to the hay show, those attending will also be able to view cattle and machinery exhibits and take part in a hay judging contest. There will also be several speakers. Hay samples should be submitted to the Travis County Extension office no later than September 15.

Winners in each of the eight hay classes at the state show will be awarded special plaques, with the grand champion entry receiving a ton of fertilizer.

We encourage all producers to strive for top quality hay this season and to submit entries for the upcoming hay shows.
