

\$2.3 Million Going To Remodeling

In Colorado County, as in any other area of the country, homeowners are on a big spruce-up spree. They are spending a record amount of money on home improvements. And they are doing much of the work themselves.

The modernization boom in various districts. Home families are remodeling their bathrooms and kitchens. They are replacing old plumbing systems or adding new. Porches and breezeways are being added to their houses.
