Heavy Damage in House Fire

At Fire Station's Back Door



Eagle Lake volunteer firemen were called to a fire last Wednesday morning almost at the back door of the fire station. They fought the fire and smoke in the A. H. 2 House Fires, Grass Fire In 3 Days

Eagle Lake volunteer firemen were called to three fires on successive days last week, two were to fire reported at homes and the third to a trash and grass fire in Altair.

At 8:45 a.m. last Wednesday the firemen were called to one of A. H. Seaholm's rent houses directly behind the fire station. The house is occupied by the John Harrison family. He is employed with Texaco Seismograph in this area.

A long freight train blocked all passageways just as the whistle sounded but fortunately a number of firemen were on the north side of the track where the fire station is located and went to the fire less than a block away with ample equipment.

An increase in local blaze, contained generally in one closet of a bedroom. The smoke made visibility difficult and the exact location of the fire was difficult to ascertain as the smoke filled the house and attic.

Contents of the closet were completely destroyed and the remainder of the house, especially the two bedrooms, had heavy smoke damage. It took the firemen almost two hours to contain the blaze and to clear the area.
