Box 37, Garwood, Texas 77445, has applied to the Texas Water Quality Board for an amendment to permit No. 10352 to allow for a discharge of domestic sewage effluent from a sewage treatment plant to serve a population equivalent of 1,000 people, which is located near the intersection of Munfield and Wirtz Streets in Garwood, Colorado County, Texas.

It is proposed that the treatment of domestic sewage effluent be discharged into the Colorado River.
