New Turbo Prop Plane For Agricultural Use

Farm & Ranch Adds Powerful

New Jet Powered Agri. Plane

Farm and Ranch Aerial Service, Inc., of Eagle Lake and Wharton, has supplemented its fleet of aircraft with an agricultural duster and sprayer with a new powerful Turbo-Prop jet powered aircraft, only the second of its kind ever to be used in agricultural flying in the state of Texas.

Eugene Shanks, owner of the firm, flew the new Marab Turbo-Prop aircraft by Airsearch and powered with a 750 horsepower Turbo Prop engine into Eagle Lake airport Tuesday afternoon, both of which were the second and third of the plane's capabilities.

For easy maneuvering on the ground the plane has a reversible prop so that it can be taxied forward or backward.

The aircraft's range is reduced to 2 to 3 miles because the powerful engine allows the plane to carry up to 3500 pounds of load in its hopper.

Shanks said that the take-off distance fully loaded is less than 100 feet, permitting use of the 1000 foot runways where aircraft might otherwise be restricted.

Because of the great power of the engine the primary feature of the new plane is the safety factor which allows maximum control of the aircraft from anywhere from 80 to 150 miles per hour. The extra speed for the return trip to the base where the plane is being loaded will help increase the number of acres that can be sprayed as compared to those serviced by the Agrijet which is primarily used for agricultural flying in this area, added Shanks.

The plane is equipped for spraying herbicides, insecticides and fertilizers. Farm and Ranch is using the new plane at this time for agricultural flying in both Wharton and Eagle Lake and the owner is impressed with the performance of the aircraft.

Shanks and Garza agreed that this undoubtedly is the best aircraft for agricultural flying. The excessive cost might slow down replacement of the aircraft currently in use.
