large sign. Hence, the matter was tabled and City Manager T. J. Smith was authorized to contact the Highway Department Wednesday to ascertain actual ownership of the property.

The city has offered Anderson \$2000 for the 10-foot wide strip of right of way along 1186 for the Anderson property. Tuesday night Anderson lowered his initial request for \$3600 for the property to \$2400.00.

The council approved a pay increase for patrolman Clark Murgage for the second session in a row. Mayor Struss reported that Murgage has received offers of more money from other agencies in the area. The council approved his pay to \$600 per month beginning May 1st. It was also voted, on recommendation of the mayor and city manager, to pay police chief Ed Aldrich and Murgage \$55.00 for each 9-hour extra shift worked during the absence of a second patrolman. The third recommendation approved was to advertise for a patrolman to succeed Steve Skinner as starting salary, provided the applicant is a certified police officer.

Mayor Struss appointed councilman Alvin Kohler as mayor pro tem and the council continued.
