New Field Discovered In Weimar Area

An indicated new field discovery in Colorado County highlights recent exploratory activity along the Texas Gulf Coast.

A dual field discovery has been gaged by Cities Service Oil flowing both oil and gas in Colorado County. The wildcat, 1 White "S", flowed 1.23 million cubic feet of gas and 153 barrels of condensate per day from lower zone perforations 9,076-82 feet in Wilcox. Flow was through a 14-64 inch choke with tubing pressure of 1,700 psi.

The upper zone from perforations 9,076-82 feet in Wilcox, flowed 367 barrels of oil per day through a 12-64 inch choke. Flowing tubing pressure was 1,852 psi. Total depth is 9,799 feet.

A field name has not yet been designated for the apparent discovery, which spots four miles southwest of Weimar. It is on a 142-acre lease in Jesse Burrah Survey 9, A-9. The well is about 3/4 mile northwest of New Belau field, which has established gas pays from 7,500 feet and 9,000 feet in Wilcox and an oil pay at 8,700 feet in Wilcox. -Weimar Mercury.
