Sherri Butler Recovering From Gunshot
Friends will be happy to hear that Sherri Butler, 10 year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Roy Lee Butler of this city, is due to be returned home this Wednesday after being confined in the St. Joseph's Hospital in Houston with an accidental gunshot wound.
Sherri and her sister were visiting with a 10 year old neighbor friend and he was sighting through a .22 caliber rifle equipped with scope glasses that the gun was loaded and the bullet entered Sherri's side and lodged in her neck. The bullet was rushed to Eagle Lake Community Hospital by her father and later transferred in Houston where the bullet was removed.
Sherri is reported to be getting along nicely and recovering and friends hope that she will not have permanent injury from the accident.
The accident occurred at 5:30 Thursday on Sec. 21 near the Butler home at 701 Church Street.

County's 3 Schools Gain \$637,200 In School Bill
State Representative John Wilson of T. Grange has released the following figures on the \$945 million public school finance bill recently passed by the Special Session of the Texas Legislature. Of this \$945 million, approximately \$345 million was provided for salary increases. \$142 million was added to equalization aid; and another \$117 million was included for program improvement. The rest of the basic school program is \$483 million. As a result of these changes, the state will assume 85 percent of the cost of the basic school program instead of the current 76 percent.
