Herbed Chicken and Rice 3 pounds chicken, cut in serving pieces salt and pepper 1/2 teaspoon each savory, rosemary, and tarragon 2 tablespoons lemon juice 1/2 cup melted butter or margarine 1 1/2 cups uncooked rice 1 1/2 cups diced celery 3 cups hot chicken broth 1/2 cup chopped peanuts, optional 1 can (4 ounces) sliced mushrooms, drained Season chicken pieces with salt and pepper. Mix savory, rosemary, tarragon, and lemon juice; add to butter. Dip chicken pieces in season- ed butter. Place in a baking pan and bake at 400 degrees for 35 to 45 minutes or until tender. Meanwhile, cook rice and celery in remaining seasoned butter until rice is golden. Add broth. Heat to boiling. Stir once. Cover. Reduce heat and simmer 15 minutes or until liquid is absorbed. Remove from heat and toss lightly with peanuts and mushrooms. Serve with chicken. Makes six servings.
