## "OVER MY SHOULDER"

(By Rodney B. Kruse, Fort City Stockyards Co., Sely and Brennan)

August was an eventful month for cow-calf operators. Dry weather prompted an early start to fall runs of cattle. Even though August receipts were 12 to 15 percent higher than July, a broad demand pushed most calf prices higher.

Slaughter cow prices were sporadic during the month but firm at the close. School use and more planned meals at home seemed to help the cow trade. Cow numbers continued to be about 20 percent of the total marketing in South and Central Texas.

Stocking markets were healthy in August and a bit brighter in September because of several reasons. In some parts of the winter grazing territory, wheat and oats have been planted, or soon will be. Many of these calves grazing interest have looked ahead and begun their purchases. Cheaper growing rates have been promised as well as cheaper finishing rations. Demand for our calves could be well maintained into the near term.

By month's end, steer calves were in the \$28 to \$42 range, choice ones in the middle \$40's, nearly to \$50. Many five-weight steers were \$37 to \$42 with heifer calves mostly \$30 to \$34, some to \$35.

Total call on feed at the beginning of July was down 3 percent from last year, according to the August Cattle on Feed report. Even though some labeled the report "bearish", others believe that in the fourth quarter, fed cattle can probably remain in the black. If fed cattle can hold around \$40, which they did in August, stay as current as they did for the month, and if grain stays at current prices, then fed cattle may show no red.

The hog market doesn't look bright, say some experts. The June inventory of hogs showed a 5 percent increase for June to November farrowings. This, coupled with cheaper grain, could increase the hog inventory.

As August ended, Central and South Texas top barrows and gilts were mostly \$40 to \$45. Because of the hot August weather reducing gains, more lighter weight hogs than usual were marketed.

August had some things going for it. Quality of calves increased over last month with many of the best calves making up almost all of the stocker and feeder runs. Supply, increased, yet demand for stocker feeders was aggressive. Cheaper grain reduced cost of gain in feedlots thereby helping fed cattle to stay clear of the red. September seems to be shaping up with the same framework going for it.
