At Food Information Day In Columbus

(By Donella Pantel, County Extension Agent) Mrs. Bernice Richter, County Health Nurse, will be screening for Diabetes, Hypertension, and Weight Control during the Colorado County Food Information Day to be held March 31st at the Columbus Veterans Community Center.

According to Mrs. Richter this type of screening and other health services are available to county residents on a daily basis but the opportunity to reach people at a public health and nutrition event is a unique way of reaching a greater number of people.

Being overweight or underweight will increase the risk of health problems. It has been proven that special diets have controlled certain patients with high blood pressure and diabetes.

"It is my purpose in the County Health Unit to promote better health—especially through education. Knowledge about diets is one of our first steps to health," she said. Mrs. Richter hopes that the public will take advantage of the free health services as well as all of the other food and nutrition information available at the Colorado County Food Information Day.

After some six hours of testimony by the complainants and others, the Columbus police officers and sheriff's deputies and others who were among the group of nine officers involved in the arrest which followed a scuffle lasting about 45 minutes.
