In an attempt to make conversation with an excited child aboard the train, the conductor asked where I was going. My reply was, "To Eagle Lake." He then asked, "And where is that, little girl?" I explained that it was in Texas. As he questioned the even further, I said, simply, "It is the Capitol of the World." And then he laughed at me! This reaction was immediately reported to my mother—and she just smiled. I realize now that she agreed wholeheartedly. My brother and I recently returned to Eagle Lake to attend the funeral services for our mother, Mrs. Mary T. Heflin. Being there once again, surrounded by friends and relatives,

parents and cousins—cousins by the dozens! There were pony rides, when the quick-thinking pony could be captured, favorite swimming holes, thick lawns glistening with dew, trees worn slick 'rvin' the climbing antics of the many young cousins, four o'clocks blooming profusely, revival meetings in the big tent, clusters of sweet, sticky honeysuckle, the magic of fireflies, the lush green fields of rice, huge mosquitoes seemingly anticipating our arrival, delicious sponges of tart dewberry jelly, the mellow sound of the tolling church bell in Lissie—but most of all, there was love.

As the years passed, inevitable changes occurred. There was, however, real disappointment to discover that the bandstand in the middle of town had been replaced with a mere Post Office. This had also brought an end to the cool sprays of water from the firehoses, which provided sheer joy and relief for the children on hot summer evenings. There is no way to determine just how many times our family went to Eagle Lake, but—even today, as familiar landmarks begin to appear, there is still the same indescribable tingle of excitement and anticipation. This feeling has not been altered by time. My life has been greatly enriched by those unforgettable journeys to Eagle Lake, Texas, "The Capitol of the World." How fortunate are those who call it home.

## NUTRITION TODAY - WEIGHT CONTROL PROGRAM STARTED

[By Donella Pantel, County Extension Agent]  
The Colorado County Extension Service has begun a Nutrition Today-Weight Control Tomorrow program in Colorado County. A fairly large percentage of men and women in Colorado County over 30 are overweight. This means they are 10 percent or more above ideal poundage for their height, body build and age. Even more alarming, 30 million Americans are overweight and 15 million Americans are obese to a degree that actually shortens their lives. There is significant correlation between obesity and ill health including cardio-vascular disease, hypertension, diabetes and arthritis. Nutrition Today Weight Control Tomorrow is the title of an informative letter series to be conducted by Mrs. Donella R. Pantel, county Extension agent. The purpose of series is to help people analyze their eating behavior; learn how to determine overweight, normal and underweight; learn how to plan nutritionally adequate meals with low calories; and learn why people overeat and how to change eating behavior to lose weight and maintain normal weight. Interested and qualified "overweights" will be enrolled on a first-come, first-serve basis until 200 have signed up. I expect many of the participants to be women, but hope to have some men, too. The registration deadline is Friday, April 27. As soon as you register, the first letter will be mailed to you. The chance of showers and thunderstorms will continue over the Texas Coastal Plains through Thursday. A Pacific front should sweep the rain out into the Gulf by early Thursday. Rainfall from some of the heavier thunderstorms could range up to an inch or more. Dry weather looks likely for Friday and Saturday. Nighttime temperatures will likely drop into the 50s Wednesday night and Thursday night; daytime temperatures are not expected to change much.

**Livestock Care:** Cattlemen should be alert for two possible dangers to cattle: footrot in cattle kept in waterlogged pastures and confinement lots may be increasing. Your veterinarian can give specific prevention and treatment recommendations.

Rapidly growing pastures could trigger tetany or emphysema in grazing cattle. The Texas Agricultural Service advises that feeding a balanced ration, including hay and grain, can help reduce the risk. Supplements rich in magnesium are also a good preventative of tetany.

**In the Rice Belt:** Wet fields and the continuing chance of rain will hamper land preparation and planting through about Thursday. Improved drying rates may allow re-entry to fields with lighter soils by the weekend or early next week.

Temperatures expected to drop into the 50s Wednesday night and Thursday night could cause more cold injury to young rice plants.

**In the Coastal Bend:** Late planting and other field work will be hampered by occasional rains through about Thursday. Drying rates, improving Friday through the weekend, should allow field work to be resumed by early next week.
