At the recent Colorado County Extension Older Texans Committee meeting, the Colorado County Extension Older Texans Fair was set for Thursday, May 3, to be held at St. Mary's Parish Hall in Nada.
Those on the committee to plan the event include: chairmen Mrs. Martha Henicke, Miss Elvie Koehn and members Mrs. Meta Gross, Mrs. Josephine Henicke, Rev. Victor Schmidtzyk, H. N. Wehner, Rev. R. B. Santiers and Lonnie Coleman.
The fair will be open to the public at 11:00 a.m. for the welcome and awards program. A lunch will be served at 11:30 a.m. and then guests will be able to view the exhibits and buy the handmade and home-grown items.
Those allowed to exhibit will be persons or organizations whose membership age is over 60 years of age. Each person or organization setting up an exhibit will need to have the exhibit set up by 10:00 a.m. to be judged prior to the 11:00 program. Each person or organization interested in exhibiting should contact the County Extension Office at 316 Spring Street in Columbus; the telephone number is 792-2530.
Rules For Entry
1. Exhibitors must be 60 years of age or older.
2. The items for sale must have been made in the time span of June 1978 and May 1979 so there are no duplications in past years' items.
3. Items must be labeled and the price included.
4. Blue, red and white ribbons will be awarded to exhibits being judged and purple ribbons given to top exhibits in the individual and organization exhibits.
5. Example categories of items to sell: (a) Handwork, (b) Needlework, (c) Baked Goods, (d) Craft Work, (e) Art Work, (f) Vegetable and place east of Columbus.
