The company filed the application on April 16th and a hearing thereon is scheduled by the Commission in the Stephen F. Austin State Office Building in Austin at 10:00 a.m. on June 8th, 1979.

Any person who intends to offer prepared testimony at the public hearing shall provide testimony with the Chief Engineer of the Commission not less than five days prior to the hearing.

Those opposing the granting of the application may appear at the hearing and/or, not less than eight days before the hearing date, may file written protests with the Commission and serve copies on the applicant.
