Now's Time To Control Pecan Nut Casebearer

The dates of May 15-20 have been set as the best time to control the pecan nut casebearer. The casebearer does damage by hollowing out the pecan nutlets during May.

Trees should be sprayed with a combination of an insecticide, fungicide, and zinc-containing material. It would be good to add a water buffering agent.

Insecticides to choose (use only one): Malathion, 1 qt. per 100 gallons of water; Sevin, 2 pounds 80% wettable powder per 100 gallons of water; Guthion, 1 1/2 pounds 25% wettable powder per 100 gallons of water. Do not graze for 21 days after application.

Fungicides to choose (use only one): Zinc sulfate, 2 pounds per 400 gallons of water; Zinc Chelate, follow directions on container.

Tree owners who need more information can contact the Colorado County Extension Office.
