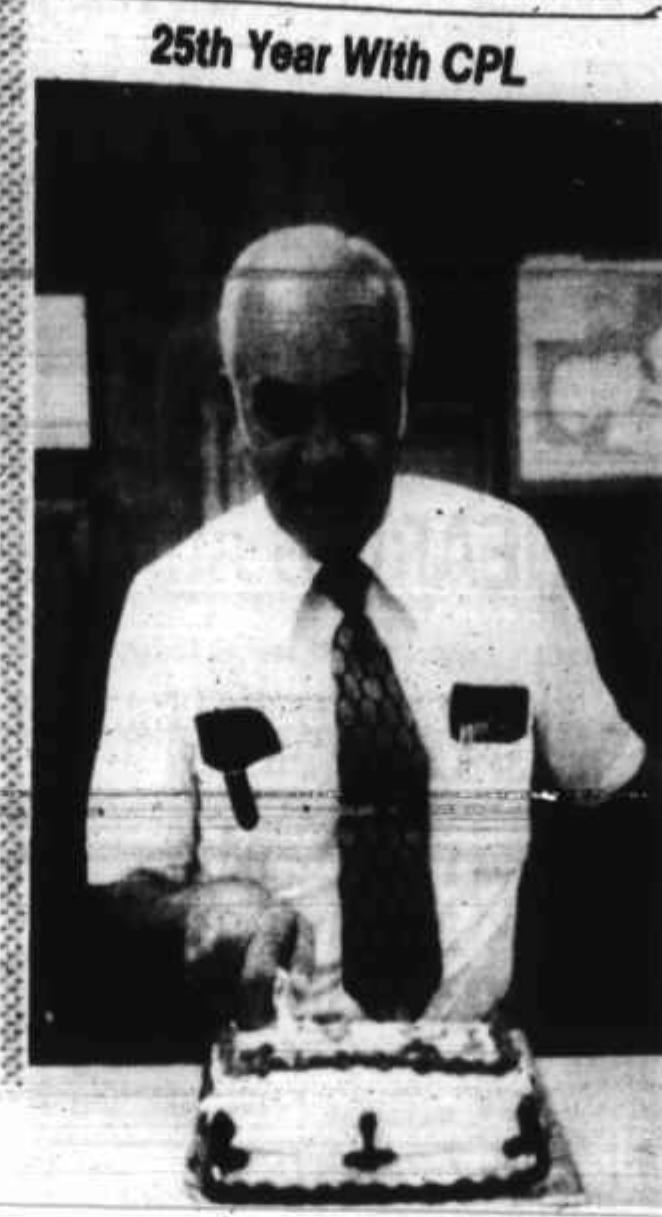

Certify Crops To ASCS By June 15th

The county office of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service reminds farmers that all farms having crops planted should report (certify) their acreages to the county ASCS office by June 15th. D. C. Streckfus, county executive director, notes that this means to come to the office on or before June 15th and not just call by phone. Crops and program acres must be reported for participating farms to plot and field - penalties are much too great to guess, added Streckfus.

It was also noted that the county ASCS office will furnish measurement service for any purpose at a minimal cost to the producer.

Other deadlines noted by the office include: May 31 is the final date to enter 1978 corn and grain sorghum into the loan; and June 14th is the final date to transfer 1979 peanut allotments from farm to farm. Any transfer after this date will be for the transfer of quota only.
