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Ambulance Corps Gets Hospital Orientation

The Eagle Lake Community Hospital was the scene for this month's Ambulance Corps training session. Mr. Anna Kessner, Director of Nurses, and Mrs. Marilyn Sparks, Supervisor of Patient Relations, were in charge of a thorough orientation of the emergency area and rooms, the idea being to put the Ambulance Corps personnel "in the picture" as to what equipment is in the E.R. and where it is kept. Then when the need arises for a doctor or nurse to say "hand me this" or "get that" the ambulance attendant has at least a passing acquaintance with what is needed. This assumes more importance when one realizes it usually happens at the height of an emergency (or multiple emergency) or when the floor staff is extremely busy.

After the orientation, Mrs. Sparks showed a film called "Hospital Support" which was a real "eye opener" because "ambulance support" can be said to "go the same route" to some extent.
