Elissa Homecoming Dedications In Galveston Sat.

A day of city-wide celebration in Galveston on August 4 will mark the homecoming of Elissa, an 1877 square-rigged ship, with free public tours of the vessel from 12:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and a free showing of a 10-minute filmstrip detailing early Elissa restoration work in Greece.

In addition, special ceremonies will dedicate Galveston's The Strand District and the East End District as National Landmarks.

The day's schedule of events is as follows:

10 a.m. - Dedication of The Strand District as a National Historic Landmark, to be held at the 1858-59 Hendley Building, 2014-16 Strand, the site of the permanent Galveston Historical Foundation offices and a Strand Visitors Center.

11 a.m. - Elissa, the 1877 three-masted barque, will be towed into Galveston Bay and berthed at Pier 22. Mary Moody Northern will welcome the ship followed by a brief ceremony. Free lemonade will be served and the city Beach Band will play.

12:30 p.m. - Free public tours of Elissa begin at Pier 22. A filmstrip of early Elissa restoration work will be shown at 30 minute intervals.

3 p.m. - Dedication of the East End District as a National Historic Landmark.

Rice Furniture Refinishers Save \$375 With Their Projects

Rice Area Homeowners saved \$375 by learning to refinish their furniture at the Rice High School Refinishing Workshop July 23-26.

Participants viewed a film on Furniture Refinishing on Monday and made plans for refinishing each person's furniture.

Steps learned in the session included learning how to clean furniture, remove the finish and repair, smooth the woods, staining and filling woods, penetrating finishes, and antiquing.

The participants completed items as small as an Antique Clock, and as large as chests and tables. Those completing the session and receiving Completion Certificates for the workshop included: Annie Kossas, Joyce Davison, Ethel Balusek, Bertha Rees, Jerry Kuba, Vera Brown, and Dorothy White.

Those sponsoring the event included Rice High School Home Economics Department, Home Economics Teacher, and Colorado County Extension Service with Mrs. Donella R. Pantel, County Extension Agent. The sessions were held daily at the Rice Vocational Agriculture Shop.

WCJC Early Registration Extended
