New Traffic Law On Aug. 27 Changes Yield Sign System

"A new traffic law going into effect soon could cause problems for motorists who do not pay attention to signs," said Carl V. Ramert, District Engineer for the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation in Yonkers. He explained that House Bill 1421 mandates that off-ramp traffic have right of way over access road traffic, and that vehicles entering existing controlled access highways from two-way frontage roads have right of way over traffic heading the opposite direction.

The Bill goes into effect August 27th and the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation must have the changeover of yield signs completed by that date. "Approximately 136 signs will be involved in this changeover in our district," Ramert said. "The changeover is not available at this time," he added.

East winds over the coastal plains are bringing moisture off the Gulf. With daytime heating, the result will be widely scattered thunderstorms each day through Saturday. Humid nights will see moderate dew lasting until about 10 a.m. the next day.

For the Rice Belt, dew will slow sorghum and rice harvests until at least 10 a.m. Rapid increases in humidity after sunset may prevent working late into evening hours. Wind problems for cotton insect control should be minor. There will also be a day to day difficulties with spotty showers. Most chemical spraying and haying will probably go smoothly but work schedules should keep some chance for rain in mind.

expenses and no capital outlay.

Health services: \$14,010; Attendance and Social Work, none.

Pupil transportation, \$61,062 in operating expenses plus \$19,500 for a new school bus or a total of \$111,162.

Co-curricular activities will receive \$28,510 with \$5,575 for capital outlay or a total of \$34,085.

Food services is allocated \$93,825.

General administration, \$152,755 plus \$46,135 for the new computer or a total of \$198,890.

Debt service requirement is listed at \$249,000 in which is \$61,000 in interest on the new bond issue for Eagle Lake school work still to be done.

Plant maintenance and operation is allocated \$326,772 in the operational fund (with increased utility costs hitting this total) plus \$6,850 for capital outlay or a total of \$333,622.

The construction program is allocated \$880,000 which is to come from the bond issue reserves plus interest to be accumulated on the funds until they are spent; and the budget allocates \$6,150 to community services.

Payroll costs under the new budget would total \$2,115,091, purchased and contracted services, \$400,978; supplies and materials \$143,905; other operating expenses, \$75,754 for a total of operating expenses of \$2,735,658 plus \$500,925 in capital outlay and \$249,000 for debt service to make the total expenditures under the budget amount to \$3,940,083.

Athletic Budget Separate

The athletic budget for the Rice School District is a separate budget and the proposed budget for 1979-80 is \$35,923. Of that amount it is estimated that \$14,900 will come from gate receipts and other similar revenue and \$21,000 from the regular

budget. Expenditures include \$7,500 for purchased and contracted services, \$19,510 for supplies and materials, and \$4,455 for other operating expenses.
