

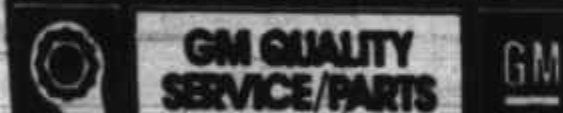

action of the commissioners' court. While the court to date has generally expressed an inclination to join the county-wide appraisal, the county's official action has been delayed. County Judge J. Crank said that the county's decision will be made final at a meeting Sept. 10th, ahead of the Sept. 15th deadline for notifying the appraisal district of the county's intention to become a part of the district.
Reports from the cities, school districts and county are due to be heard at Thursday's meeting in the county courtroom as ground work is laid for eventually forming the countywide appraisal district by the January 1, 1980 deadline set out in S.B. 621.

county were \$276,000 when the program started and the 1980 estimates are for only \$127,000, said the judge. He cited as evidence of the low cost of the program the fact that the county's tax rate is one of the lowest in the state.
Judge Crank also pointed out that the county plans to join the countywide appraisal district since it would be inadvisable for the county to spend money to develop a 100% fair market value on property, and the countywide district do the same, as will become necessary under

state law on January 1, 1982.

The county has until Sept. 15th to decide if it will or will not join the countywide appraisal district, but Judge Crank indicated that the favorable decision is likely at the Sept. 10th meeting.

This, he explained, will require additional funds, the extent of which will be determined by the board of directors elected by the entities participating in the countywide appraisal district. Precinct 4 Commissioner Bill Stiles asked if the county could drop out of the appraisal district if it is not desired, at the end of a year, and the judge said that he interpreted the law to allow such action. However it was noted that voters in the state will cast ballots on a constitutional amendment which would give the state legislature in 1981 the authority to mandate that counties be included in the countywide appraisal district. Under current law, the county has the option to do so but must decide by Sept. 15th if it will or will not join the district for the next tax year.

Vote Is Unanimous
In the action taken by the commissioners, as an unanimous vote, the 1979 tax rate will be 64¢ for the ad valorem tax, 90¢ for additional ad valorem (with the \$3000 homestead exemption continued), 10¢ of the ad valorem tax is earmarked for the courthouse restoration, and the county previously allowed for early payment, 3% in October, 2% in November and 1% in December will be continued; and the county will collect one-half of the income fees charged by the state for beer, wine, package store, etc. licenses.

Bank Asks Judgment On Past Due Note
First National Bank of Eagle Lake filed suit Aug. 14th against Michael Hoffman of Altair seeking judgment for an alleged past due promissory note.
In the district court suit, the plaintiff says that the balance owing on the promissory note signed Feb. 24, 1979 is \$3,081.80 and the bank asks for judgment in that amount, plus \$61.50 for late payment charges, and that the defendant be obligated to pay interest, attorney's fees and costs of court.

Sausage Co. Seeks to Regain Eqt. Payment

The Double B Sausage Co. of Weimar filed suit in District Court Fri. Aug. 10th against T. C. Laughlin, Inc., a Texas corporation, seeking return of \$5,100 which the plaintiff says was given to the defendant to locate, locate and purchase equipment for the sausage company.
The petition alleges that on Feb. 8, 1979, the sausage company contracted with Laughlin to locate and purchase the equipment and paid \$5,100 with which to make the purchase. The plaintiff alleges that the defendant has not been able to locate the equipment and has not returned the money and asks for judgment for return of the \$5,100 plus attorney's fees and costs of court.
