### Historical Comm. Hears History Of Glidden

The Colorado County Historical Commission held its meeting on Sept. 20 in Glidden. Preceding a covered dish supper and business meeting, Mrs. Dorothy J. Heine gave the history of Glidden. She had done extensive research and has been planning to write a book. The townsite for Glidden, Texas was granted Aug. 3, 1885 to W. B. Dewey. The plat was filed in 1885, but some people were no doubt here before 1835. Some of the early families were: T. J. Oaks Family, who bought land in 1867; F. N. Mahon Family, who worked for the railroad; J. A. Paterson, first postmaster in 1888; the Schulenburg Family, two brothers walked from Schulenburg with gold in buckets to buy land in Glidden; P. W. Oberhaus and W. E. Oberhaus, who worked for the railroad and F. J. Glidden, railroad engineer for whom the town was named. Glidden's history parallels the rise and fall of the railroads. Kerpene lanterns were the first signals before batteries. In 1895 a steel tumbler was built in the first yard. In 1891 Dunn and Bradstreet listed three stores and three saloons. In 1916 Glidden's voting box was established and it was also the year of women's suffrage. Around 1925 Glidden got electrical power. The Sunset News was Glidden's only newspaper. It was published by the Baptist minister and was named for Sunset Road. In 1925 the first baseball team was organized. In 1929 Mrs. P. A. Bryman gave the National Defense report covering the Panama Canal treaty, Soviet blockade in Africa, Salt II and the need of expanding military defense. Reports from the Committees were given. Mrs. Delbur Swanson gave the program "The Proposed Constitutional Amendment to Balance The Federal Budget." Convention Calls have been made by 30 States and 4 more States. A call will have to be made by Congress. Refreshments were served during the social hour. The members present went to the Old Fellows Cemetery to place a D.A.R. grave marker on the grave of a deceased member, Mrs. J. D. Seymour (Jeanette Miles). Reporter.
