The long-awaited Fortieth Anniversary reunion of the Eagle Lake High School Class of 1939, held last Saturday evening at The Farris 1912, proved to be every bit as exciting and entertaining as anticipated.

The group gathered for a social hour at The Farris 1912, beginning at 7:00 p.m., and much merriment was enjoyed as the class members reunited for the first time since their 20th annual reunion was held in 1959.

Kathryn (Skeeters) Eliand of Houston, led in the invocation before the delicious buffet menu of roast beef and rice and the trimmings was enjoyed.

Decorations for the tables were in keeping with the Eagle Lake High School colors of black and orange; and at each place was an orange program containing highlights of the past forty years as summarized by Mayor Elmer Struss, a member of the class and director of arrangements for the event; and also the class picture and interesting excerpts from "The Eagle" published in the Headlight during 1939. Cong. Pickle Reports On Legislation

The House of Representatives wound up a busy week taking decisive action on several important measures, as it faced the end-of-September deadline before the start of Fiscal Year 1980. Since the activity was so fast and furious, I'll touch on several issues.

On a second try, the House passed the second budget resolution, which sets final targets of spending during Fiscal Year 1980. The budget deficit was pegged at \$28.9 billion. I voted against this resolution, because of the alarming deficit increase in just a few months. This first resolution last spring totaled less than \$24 billion, and the new deficit figure was estimated too low for a padded estimate, because it was based on Ways and Means Committee changing the law to collect taxes faster, which may not occur. One of my overriding goals has been to balance the budget at the end of Fiscal Year 1981. A \$28.9 billion deficit, which in reality is closer to \$35 billion, represents a serious setback.

The House this week went on to pass legislation implementing the Panama Canal Treaty. I voted for this legislation. Both supporters and foes of the treaty agreed that without this bill, control of the canal would have totally passed out of American hands into a total takeover by the Panamanian government on October 1 of this year. While I have some reservations about the treaty, failure to pass this implementing legislation would have been a big blow to our national security, since the American presence in the canal would have been eliminated.

In other action, the House passed an increase in the national debt ceiling. Many members are reluctant to raise this ceiling, since it is a sign we have not yet stopped our reckless deficit spending. However, a debt ceiling represents money that has already been spent. If we avoided extending this limit, programs that benefit millions of Americans would grind to a halt. Taking this action sounds bad, but it is necessary. The silver lining in this cloud is that we tied the debt ceiling to the budget process. Lying the rug together will put stronger impetus upon balancing the budget and trimming back.

Finally, the House completed the long legislative journey of creating a new Department of Education. I supported the conference committee report because a separate department will cut out much confusion surrounding education programs in the immense HEW bureaucracy. It is far easier to get agreement on touch issues when we are facing a deadline in this case, the end of the fiscal year, when necessary government functions must go on uninterrupted.

HERE'S HOW!

Every cord has a small plug to connect it to a circuit. The detachable cords used with many small appliances also have a female plug connected to the appliance. Any plug that has a cracked shell or loose contacts should be replaced with a new one. A plug that sits loose in a socket should be examined to be sure that the wires are firmly seated in the terminals. Some cracked plugs can be checked visually, but will betray poor connections by transmitting power erratically or becoming even warmer to the touch after a period of use.
