Document Flood, Fire Losses for IRS

Area residents with house or property damage from fire or flood probably can deduct the loss on the federal income tax return to be filed beginning in January. However, it is important to document losses in order

to substantiate deductions of insured losses on income tax returns. The IRS requires that every individual item that was damaged or destroyed be inventoried or itemized. Such a list should include the item, the amount originally paid for it, its estimated fair market

value before the flood or fire and the estimated fair market value after the damage (which could be zero if it was a total loss). If you have listed all the damaged items, add up the loss in fair market value of each and the total amount figures into your deduction.

Several costs are excluded from deductions and include the following:

"The cost of cleaning up, hauling off damaged property and the like isn't deductible."

"The first \$100, after you add up losses on real estate and personal property, isn't deductible. For example, if your total loss figured by the IRS was \$1,000, you deduct only \$900."

"If insurance pays for some or all of the loss, subtract that reimbursement from the total loss to determine the amount to be deducted on the income tax return."

"If you have to move into a motel or other temporary quarters because of the flood or fire, the temporary living expenses cannot be deducted."
