John Thomas Cited For Reclamation Work

Eagle Lake Native Is Founder Of American Hydro-Grass, Houston

American Hydro-Grass Company of Houston, founded by John R. Thomas of Eagle Lake, has been featured in the lead article in the October issue of "Weeds, Trees and Turf" magazine, a national business journal of vegetation management. The article features the work of three independent contractors from Kentucky, Georgia and Houston, Texas. Following is an excerpt from the article:

"John R. Thomas, President and General Manager of American Hydro-Grass Company, forged into the reclamation business by approach ing oil refineries and petrochemical plants with the idea of reclamation. Besides selling companies such as Exxon, Gulf Oil and Diamond Shamrock on the aesthetic appearance of a reclaimed area, Thomas showed them that grass and other vegetation is a much more effective erosion control device than the more expensive methods of cement and rock lining in most cases."

Three contracts with the oil companies for these jobs, which usually cover between 210 acres, have increased his company's sales "substantially" during the past year, he says.

"Though his competition has increased about five percent during the past year, Thomas is also working as a consultant to some of these firms, even when they win a contract he would have liked to have."

Pecan Show To Be Record

Indications show that the Colorado-Fayette County Pecan-Bake Show will be even bigger and better than the 1978 show due to a record pecan crop this year.

According to Donella R. Paniel, Colorado County Extension Agent, the doubled entries last year should be compared to the potential this year. This year the Pecan Show, Pecan Bake Show, and Pecan Poster Show will be held at the Weimar City Hall in Weimar, Texas, December 4 and 5. The public is welcome December 4 after the judging from 5:00-7:00 p.m. and from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon December 5 to view the entries and purchase a home baked item made with pecans.

Two new attractions besides the pecan judging and the pecan bake show will be a Pecan Poster Art Show sponsored through the schools and a Pecan Food Preparation Demonstration utilizing a roquefort and conventional oven.

Holiday Ideas
Texas pecans give a fancy touch to every sort of holiday taste treat.
This year, say "Make mine Texas pecans," since the Lone Star State produced its largest crop ever.

Then fancy up the holiday season with these quick-easy ideas:
-Serve soup cream with pecans on meat or baked potatoes.
-For waffles, biscuits or muffins, add pecans into blended dry ingredients before adding the liquid.
-Add pecans to meat, poultry or seafood salads.
-Try seafood or sliced pecans in tossed vegetable salads.
-Roll ice cream balls in chopped pecans. Freeze balls separately until set.
-Use toasted, chopped pecans as a quick topping for cream pie or ice cream pie.

Pecan Growers Can Get New Money From Wood

Pecan producers in Colorado and Fayette counties found out on Nov. 8th that their trees are valuable for wood products as well as nuts. They participated in a training program by the counties, pecan committees to teach them how to thin this native pecan groves. They also were shown how to estimate the number of board feet and what kinds of wood products can be made from trees that have to be removed from the groves.

Removing these trees allows the better trees to get plenty of sunlight, therefore increasing nut production. The training was conducted by Texas Agricultural Extension Service forestry and horticulture specialists from College Station, Uvalde and Houston. They worked together to show that timber and nut production
