Provide This Info When Reporting Fires

(Clip this information provided by the city's Volunteer Fire Dept. and place near your phone for reference in event of an emergency.)

The following information is printed to help those persons who may have to call to report a fire or other emergency.

You should write all emergency numbers on a note or post near your phone. They are usually inside the front cover of your telephone directory. The number to call for help from the Eagle Lake Volunteer Fire Department is 234-2533. Persons living in other surrounding communities should check with their own fire department for the best and fastest call number. The Eagle Lake Department will support and back up any rural department on major alarms.

When calling in a fire or any other emergency one should give the dispatcher the exact location of the fire with the fullest description of the location, nature of the emergency and any other information that can be used to dispatch the department to the exact scene in the shortest possible time, route and with equipment that would be best suited to handle the situation.

You should give your name and telephone number if you are reporting a fire for someone else. This gives the dispatcher a contact number if any need arises.

You should go over these instructions with your baby sitter and children. After reporting a fire one should get out in the open as soon as you can safely do so. Material things may be replaced but a life lost in a fire is forever.

Make Pleas

pleas of nole contendre to a charge of involuntary manslaughter in the death of Barbara Ehrineberg, a pedestrian, Sept. 17, 1979 was given a term of five years probation and fined \$300 and court costs.

Janie Gaskamp, indicted June 11 on a charge of beating to death with her hands her 3 1/2 mo.-old son on May 10, 1979, was assessed punishment of three years in the Texas Department of Corrections. However, since she would not waive the ten-day period for a possible plea for a new trial, formal sentencing will be at the end of that period. The original indictment against Gaskamp was for murder and this was reduced to involuntary manslaughter.

Bonds Revoked
Judge Schraub accepted motions of the state's attorneys to revoke the bond of Hack William Lockhart, on a charge of credit card abuse. Lockhart had waived indictment on the charge, but he failed to appear. Also, bonds of Jerry Lou Naylor and John E. Naylor, indicted for aggravated assault in using a handgun to threaten Connie Lange on Nov. 18th, 1978, were ordered revoked when the defendants failed to appear.

Guilty Pleas
Entering pleas of guilty to indictments were: Roy Lee Shaw for burglary of the Wilcox Minimax of Eagle Lake Oct. 3rd; Garrison Coye Purvis for possession of a controlled substance (methamphetamine) on Sept. 23rd of this year; Ramon Navarro Rodriguez for unauthorized use of a 1974 Gremlin belonging to Ralph Gerlin on Oct. 5th; James Tucker for possession of marijuana in an amount over four ounces, Aug. 31 of this year.

Also pleading guilty was Donald Friend, indicted June 11 for statutory rape of a girl under 17 on June 9, 1979.

Sentencings on these pleas of guilty will be made on January 3rd.

Leonard Thompson, indicted for criminal mischief for damage at Skull Creek Lodge July 23, appeared and Judge Schraub deferred judgment to a later date.
