the question to Judge Crank as to how much of the wiring done in a renovation project in 1952 would be reusable. Judge Crank responded that investigation has found that much of the wiring installed at that time did not meet the 1952 state standards and will have to be replaced. The architectural firm of Wilbort and Associates in preparing plans for the renovation has been advised for replacing the 1952 wiring since it was thought to have met the standards and would be reusable.

The electrical sub-contractor is at this time preparing an addendum for consideration of the court on expenditures to be made for the wiring up to state standards.

Judge Crank and the commissioners noted the seriousness of the sub-standard wiring was illustrated when calling the line in the basement of the courthouse was grounded and it was found that one junction box had evidently been overloaded.

County To Continue Tax On Vehicles In 1980

Colorado County Commissioners' Court, in session Monday, passed an order that all vehicles will remain on the county tax rolls for the year of 1980. Such action was taken since Senate Bill 621 and House Bill 1040 state that exemption of the first two vehicles, used for family purposes, in each family would be exempt from taxes unless such action was nullified by action of the county's governing body.

In other action the court: Passed an order approving the plat of a 43.07 acre subdivision between Colorado and Garwood, approved the road in the subdivision, contingent on the fact that the road had adequate gravel on it. Cal Housworth of Katy, developer of the subdivision, met with the court and made the request and also discussed with the court a plan for a cooperative plan for paving the road next year.

Further details on the paving project will be worked out by Commissioner Otto Loeasini, who presides the subdivision, for further consideration of the court.
