Kolek, Trefny Are Pecan Show Champs

[By Leroy J. Hajdik County Extension Agent] Frank Kolek, Jr. of Weimar and Charles T. Trefny of Weimar were champion winners in the Colorado/Fayette County Pecan Show held December 4 and 5 at the Weimar City Hall. Reserve Champion winners included Walter Roeder of Schulerburg, Charlie Harkusky of Holman and Lawrence Loessli of Weimar.

The 1979 show had 151 total entries: 84 entries were In-Shell varieties, 27 were Shelling varieties, and 39 were Native.

Pecans were divided into three major divisions according to use. In-Shell pecans are those varieties which have less than 50 nuts per pound and are usually sold to be home cracked. Shelling pecans are those improved varieties that have more than 50 nuts per pound that are produced for the machine shelling market and are sold shelled. Natives are the third major division and consist of all the unnamed natives which are usually marketed in the shelling markets.
