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Ron Glover Is Key To TLC Basketball Team

A 6'8" forward from Altair, Ron Glover is one of the keys to the Texas Lutheran College (TLC) basketball team in Seguin, Texas. That is certain to be a competitor for the big state Conference basketball championship this year.

Glover, a 1976 graduate of Rice High School, has started for the Bulldogs since his sophomore year and saw much action as a freshman. He is an excellent outside shooter and this year he is the third leading scorer on the team, averaging 11 points per game after nine games. In addition, Glover has been hitting 55 percent of his field goals and 66.7 percent of his free throws.

As the tallest man on the squad, Glover's height presents problems to the opposing defense, and he leads the team in rebounds with 78, for an average of 8.7 per game. The Bulldogs have

a season record of five wins and four losses. While at Rice, Glover helped Coach Jack Grammer's Raiders reach the first round of the state Class AAA basketball tournament in Austin in 1975. In 1976 he was an all-district performer on a Zone champion team.

After his graduation, the big man was heavily recruited by TLC, as well as several other schools, and decided to continue his education and basketball career with them. Prior to the current season, TLC Coach Jack Grammer praised Glover's ability and emphasized his importance to the team.

"Ron will be a key player in our success this year," said Grammer. "He has the potential to be an outstanding player and one of the best in the Big State Conference."

Ron is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Clifton Glover of Altair.

8 Boys', 8 Girls' Teams In Jr. Hi Cage Tourney Here Jan. 3-5

The Eagle Lake Middle School will host its annual Basketball Tournament on January 3-4-5 at the Middle School gymnasium with both seventh and eighth grade boys' and girls' divisions. Four teams will be participating in each division with teams from East Bernard, Columbus, Seely, Bellville and Schulenburg, as well as Eagle Lake taking part.

Only girls' games will be played on Jan. 3rd, with the ELMS eighth graders hosting East Bernard in the first game at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday. Columbus will meet Schulenburg at 3:15 in the other eighth grade girls' match.

The ELMS seventh grade will host East Bernard at 4:30 Thurs. Jan. 3 for the first game in their division. Columbus will battle Bellville at 5:45 in the other seventh grade girls' game.

The boys' divisions open play on Jan. 4th with ELMS School will host East Bernard at 2:00 and Columbus playing Seely at 3:15. In the seventh grade division, which also opens play on Friday, East Bernard will meet ELMS at 4:30 and Columbus will play Seely in the other match.

Finals Sat., Jan. 4th will get underway on morning of Jan. 5th with the seventh grade girls championship game at 9:30 and eighth grade finals at 11:30 a.m. The seventh grade boys' finals will be at 10:15 a.m. with the eighth grade championship game scheduled to start at 12:45 p.m. Both girls' consolation games will be played Thursday evening and both boys' consolation games will be played on Friday evening.

Public invited Tickets for the tournament will be 50c for students and \$1.00 for adults at the door. Adults may purchase a tournament ticket, good for all games, for \$2.00.

Overall, the Raiders have had a very successful first half of the season and are expected to continue their ways through the remainder. The coaches and players invite everyone to plan to attend as many games as possible during the tournament and cheer them on to victory.

The Raiders will play only one game during the next week of action and that will be in Victoria against Stroman with three games slated beginning with the freshmen at 2:00 Thursday.

That game will mark the final non-district contest for Rice before they open their regular District 20AA play. The Raiders have already chalked up two district wins in games played in the middle of December. They will host

Another starter, 6-1 senior forward Dennis Bluntson, was benched because of a small fracture that broke out in the opening minutes of the final quarter. D. Bluntson was replaced by Brother Frasier who filled in adequately to help keep the Raiders on top.
