Eligible producers may vote any time between Tues. Feb. 19th and Fri. Feb. 22nd at the County ASCS office, Adkins said. Registration for the vote was held Jan. 28-Feb. 5.

His most serious injuries were reported to be a fractured pelvis and internal complications. He was treated in Lavaca County Medical Center and transferred to DeTar Hospital in Victoria.

### Announcement On '80 Rice Awaited

No official announcement has been received yet on the 1980 Rice Program announced by the County ASCS office in its monthly bulletin.

The conservation program in Colorado County was approved early and is on-going at this time. The same practices are applicable in 1980 as last year such as: grass planting, liming, erosion ponds, gully shaping, pipelines, water well, brush clearing, cross-fencing, diversion terraces, and tree planting (pines). The Development Group has approved a well balanced program for the county which fits all needs at the present. If you are interested in details call or write the county ASCS office. Be sure to apply and be approved by the committee before starting a practice if cost shares are to be earned, notes Daniel C. Streckfus, county executive director.

**Cotton and Grain Program**  
It has been announced that there will be no required set-asides for cotton, corn, grain sorghum, wheat or barley in 1980. If there are any changes in the above announcement the county ASCS office will advise you promptly.

**Cotton and Rice Deficiency**  
No deficiency payments will be made for the 1979 crops of upland cotton or rice. The average market prices received by farmers during

the marketing year have exceeded the target prices for these commodities.

### How To Make A Valentine Cake

Make a perfectly shaped Valentine cake with just two cake pans. Bake one and a round one and share it with someone you love.

Use your favorite icing and decorate the cake as desired for a quick and simple Valentine treat.

If you're history-minded, here are some other tidbits for mulling as you make the cake or share it with someone.

There are many ideas about how the name Valentine came to be connected with the day on which lovers send tokens of affection to one another. One is based on the belief throughout Europe during the Middle Ages that the birds began to mate on February 14.

In addition to honoring Saint Valentine, February 1980 takes on an extra special air of romantic antiquity with the observance of "Lovers Leap Season" or "Leap Year." This holiday occurs once every four years with the appearance of an extra day in February - "Leap Day" - and retains the mysterious belief - that women may propose marriage "so men with perfect proposals throughout the entire year."

Yes, being an old English saying, ladies may propose during Leap Year, and, if rejected, they may claim a silk gown. And in many a European town or country, there allegedly have been "leap marriages" where the bride and groom were not known to each other until the ceremony.

In the United States and in New England there used to be a curious belief that during Leap Year beans grow on the wrong side of the pod. No matter what the origin or belief of Valentine customs, you can still share the heart shaped cake with a special person.

### MARKET REPORT

**Columbus Livestock Market**  
Owners of the Columbus Livestock Market reported stock calves were the most active classes at the Feb. 7th sale with the light calves being sold \$1 to \$15 per hundred higher with a lot of cattle as high as they have ever seen.

The firm handled 584 head of cattle with cow and calf pairs in demand. Good to choice butcher calves and yearlings sold 68 to 75; heifer calf packer cows 59 to 65; and commercial packer bulls 65 to 70. Heavy Hereford and Angus steer calves and crossbred steer calves brought 80c to \$1.00 while heifers went for 75 to 90.

### Trailer Home In Altair Destroyed By Fire



Eagle Lake Volunteer Firemen were dispatched to the scene of this trailer home fire in Altair Friday at 10:35 a.m. The trailer, owned by J. Robinson, was completely destroyed by the blaze, which fire officials believe started in the kitchen at the rear of the home, either from the stove or hot water heater. No one was in the trailer at the time. Upon arrival, the local firemen found the home engulfed in flames with thick smoke pouring from the structure (top photo). A strong wind hampered firefighting efforts, but the fire was brought under control in about 30 minutes. All three trucks at the scene used their complete water supply and had to refill their tanks at the Skull Creek Lodge swimming pool. Pumps on the trucks were used to pump the water from the pool. A unit was called back to the scene about 2:30 that afternoon after the strong winds had rekindled some debris in the area.
