Not much sunshine is likely in the Coastal Plains until late in the week. Widely scattered showers are forecast to develop across the region Wednesday ahead of the next cold front. The showers may linger into Thursday as a front passes along the coast. Fair, mild weather should follow Friday and Saturday.

In the Rice Belt, Wet fields will continue to lose moisture slowly under humid conditions. Showers Wednesday and Thursday could aggravate the situation in some areas. Rainfall amounts Wednesday should be generally under one-half inch. Soil temperatures are likely to remain on the cool side for good rice germination until sunshine returns.
