The Girls Track team has ended their 1980 track season. They competed in four invitational track meets and the District meet this year. The results are as follows:

In the first meet in Needville, Rice ranked eighth out of fourteen schools competing. The highlights were Joyce Parker placing second in the triple jump; third in long jump, and Mary-Beck third in the 800 yard run.

In the Palacios Track Meet, Rice ranked ninth out of fourteen schools. Joyce Parker highlighted the meet with a first place in long jump; third in triple jump, and the 800 yard relay team placed third.

At the Binn College Women's Invitational, Joyce Parker won third in the long jump, Mary Beck second in the long jump.

The last invitational meet was at Hallettsville with Rice placing third. The highlights were Gloria Amos first in long jump, Joyce Parker first in long jump, third in triple jump, Mary Beck second in the 800 meter run, and the 800 meter relay team placed third.

At the District meet, Joyce Parker won third in the long jump, Mary Beck fifth in the 800 meter, and the 800 meter relay team placed sixth.

## Earn Beauty Operator's License



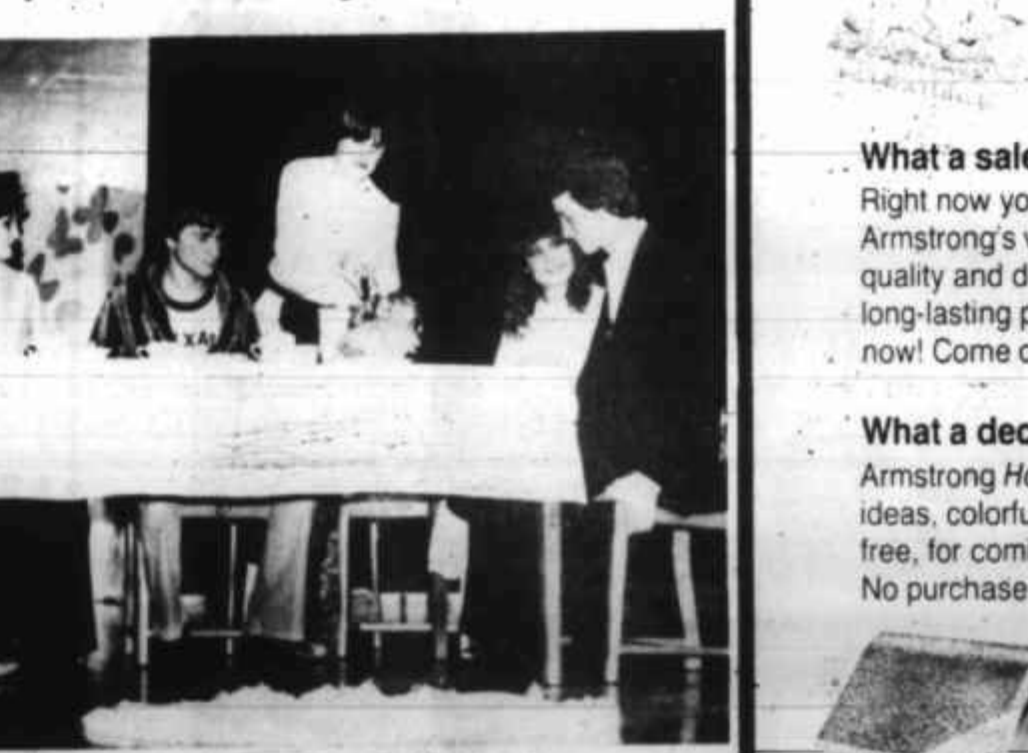

## Nine Rice Cosmetology Seniors Receive License

Nine Rice High School Cosmetology senior students qualified for their State Beauty Operators License as a result of passing the State Board Examination. The test was administered in Austin at the Texas Cosmetology Commission on April 3, 1980. The students were required to demonstrate their competency in a laboratory setting and their knowledge of the academic requirements with a written test. The test took a total of six hours and thirty minutes.

In order to qualify to take the examination, the students had to have a total of 1000 hours (two 500 academic). The Cosmetology Department is one of the most professional programs at Rice. That program's students, with a professional skill qualification, the success of the program is a reflection of the ability of the instructor, Mrs. Florence McMan. To encourage and teach her students, she has written test questions with a total of six hours and thirty minutes.
