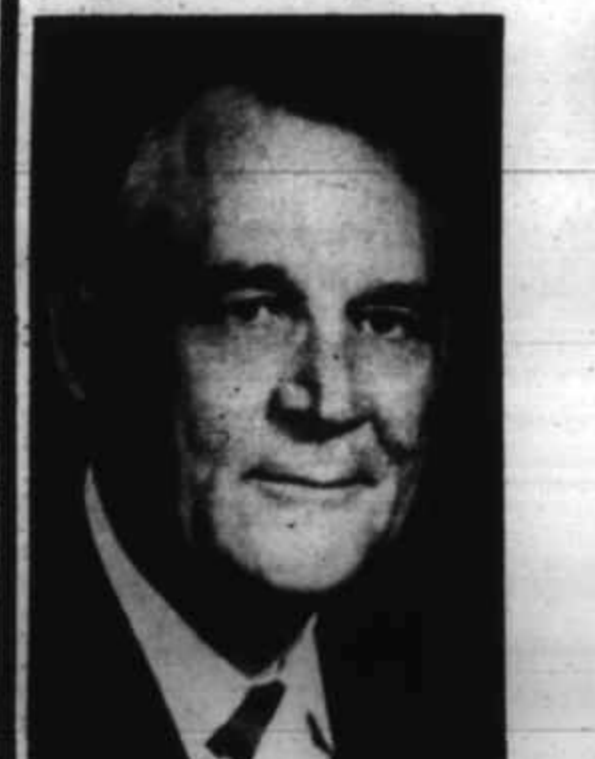
EDITORIALLY SPEAKING

DISABLED EXEMPTION I hereby affirm that I was under a disability program for purposes of payment of disability benefits under Federal Old-Age, Survivors and Disability Insurance as of January 1, 1980.

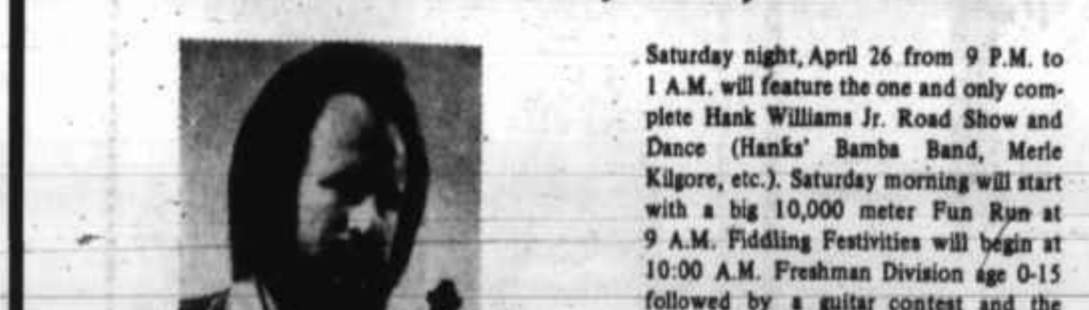

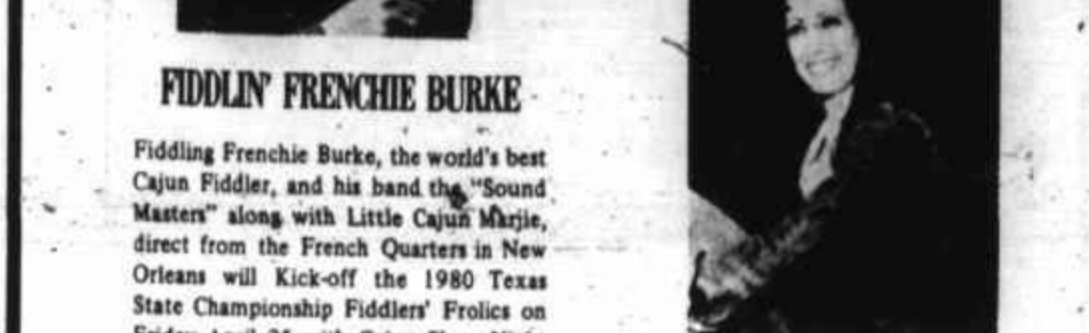

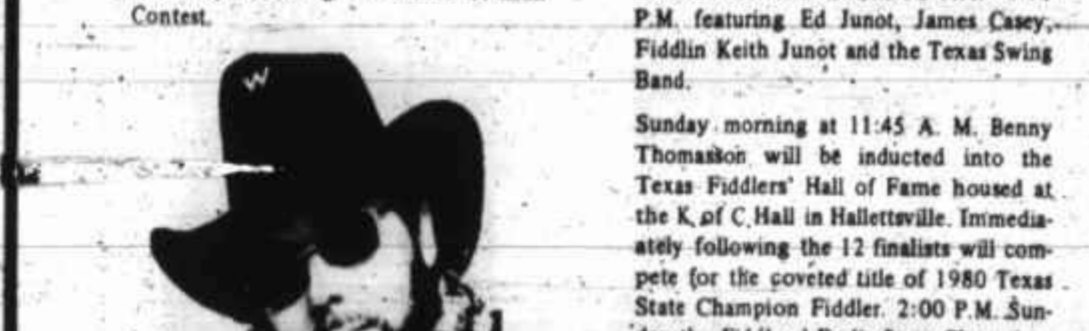
State Championship Fiddlers' Frolic In Hallettsville Fri., Sat., and Sun.
