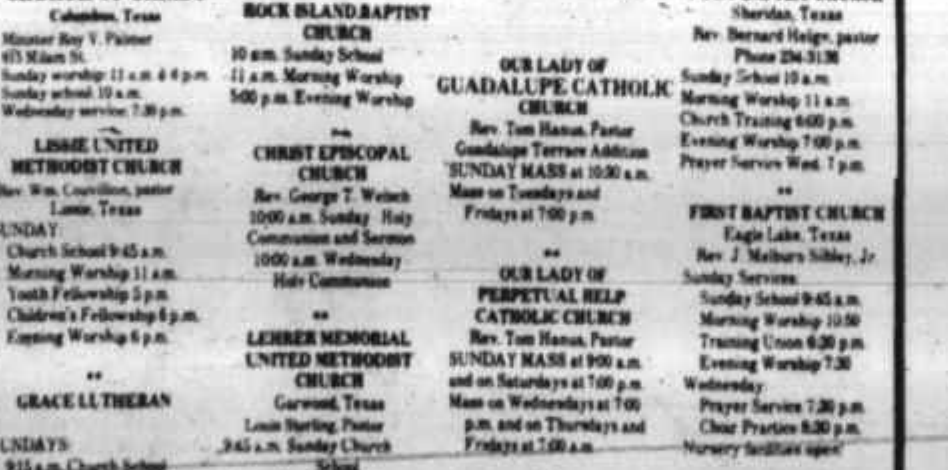

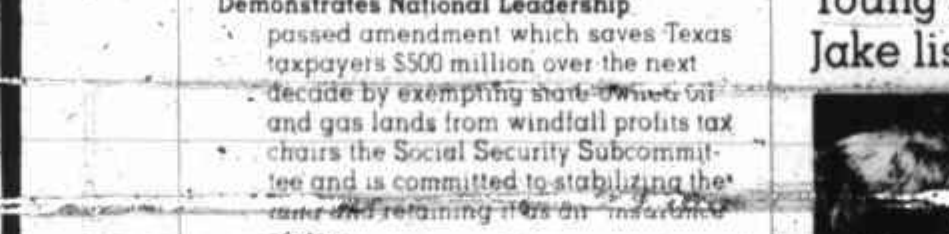

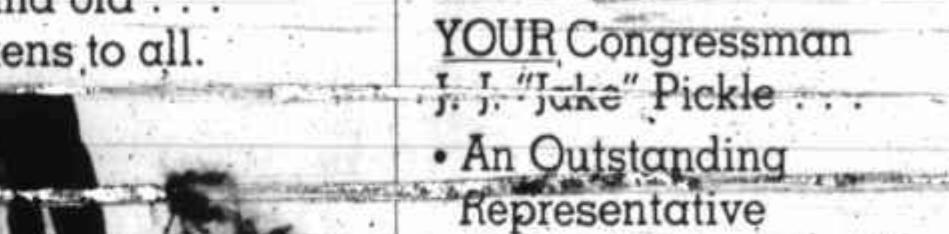

I take a different viewpoint. Our people have held hostage for nearly six months... international law, and human decency.

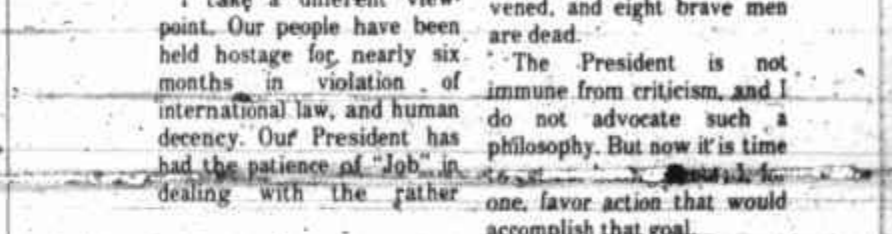
