Commr. Court OK's Lease For Columbus Airport

Colorado County Commissioners' Court, in session Monday, accepted a 20-year lease assignment from the Columbus Airport Foundation for an airport which will be located about three miles south of Columbus on Robert R. Wells, Jr., property.
James Whitcomb, a member of the Foundation's board, met with the court and asked approval of the lease assignment for the proposed airport site. He said that the Columbus Airport Foundation will pay rent on the lease to Mr. and Mrs. Robert R. Wells, Jr. The tract involved includes 38.59 acres but the portion being leased to the county is the west 265-feet of the property which will be used for a 50-foot wide 4100-foot long runway and a public parking area, a tie-down area and for a lounge area. The county will be obligated to build a paved runway and maintain the runway once the Foundation completes laying a six-inch compacted gravel base.
Whitcomb also discussed the possibility of extending the runway to 5000-feet by acquiring property from an adjoining property owner and by improving drainage in a ditch area.
The court accepted the lease assignment unanimously on motion of Precinct 1 Commissioner Otto Loessin in whose precinct the airport lies.
Other Action
In other action the court:
Approved a request from the City of Austin, a public electrical utility, for road crossings for a new transmission line from the South Texas Nuclear Plant near Matagorda to Austin, crossing County Roads 204, 201, 26, 27, 28, 103, 105, 111, and 116 in Precincts 1 and 2.

Local Man Charged In Damage at Alamo
