LEGAL NOTICES

PUBLIC NOTICE City of Eagle Lake, P.O. Box 35, Eagle Lake, Texas 77434 has applied to the Texas Department of Water Resources for a renewal of Permit No. 106561 which authorizes a discharge of treated domestic sewage effluent at a volume not to exceed an average flow of 500,000 gallons per day from the treatment facilities which are located approximately 400 feet south of the intersection of U.S. Highway 90-A Bypass and McCarty Avenue in Eagle Lake, Colorado County, Texas.

The treated domestic sewage effluent is discharged into a drainage ditch, thence to Eagle Lake, thence to the Colorado River.

The permit, if renewed by the Commission, will specify conditions and limitations generally the same as those currently enforced by the existing permit, except the authorized discharge volume will be specified as 250,000 gallons per day until completion of proposed facility expansion. The expiration date of the existing permit was May 27, 1980. It is proposed that the expiration date be extended to midnight, five years after date of Commission approval.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Section 26.028 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, and Chapter 25 of the Rules of the Texas Department of Water Resources. No public hearing will be held on this application unless an affected person who has received notice of the application has requested a public hearing and/or requests further information concerning any aspect of the application should be submitted in writing to Larry R. Soward, Assistant Chief Hearings Examiner, Texas Water Commission, P.O. Box 13087, Capitol Station, Austin, Texas 78711. Telephone (512) 475-1311. Issued this 9th day of July, 1980.
