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Election On Sale Of Gas System

ORDINANCE
AN ELECTION TO SELL THE NATURAL GAS UTILITY, PROVIDING AND FIXING DETAILS RELATING THERETO; AND DECLARING THAT SAID ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Lake has been advised by an appointed Citizens Committee to sell the natural gas utility;

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of said City wishes to proceed with the ordering of said election; Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE LAKE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That an election shall be held in and throughout the City of Eagle Lake, Texas, on the 20th day of September, 1980, which is not less than fifteen nor more than ninety days from the date of this ordinance, at which election the following proposition shall be submitted to the duly qualified resident electors of said City for their action thereupon, to-wit:

PROPOSITION
AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL TO DISPOSE OF THE NATURAL GAS UTILITY TO PRIVATE OR CORPORATE INTEREST.

Section 2: That the entire City shall constitute one election precinct, and said

election shall be conducted and held at the Municipal Building, Council Room, situated at 100 East Main Street, in the City of Eagle Lake, Texas, and the following named persons are hereby appointed officers to conduct said election, to-wit:

H. E. Tate, Presiding Judge;
Gail Bradshaw, Alternate Presiding Judge;
The Presiding Judge shall appoint as many Clerks as he deems necessary for the proper conduct of the election, provided such number of Clerks shall be at least two and not more than four.

Section 3: That absentee voting shall be conducted by the City Secretary, Miss Lucille Perry, at her regular office in the Municipal Building of the City of Eagle Lake, Texas, and the City Secretary shall keep said office open for at least eight (8) hours on each day for absentee voting which is not a Saturday, Sunday, or an official State holiday.

Section 4: That voting in said election, including absentee voting, shall be by written or printed ballots which shall conform to the requirements of the Texas Election Code, as amended, and shall have printed thereon the following:

OFFICIAL BALLOT
Place an "X" in the square beside the statement indicating the way you wish to vote.

Section 5: That all election materials including notice of the election, ballots, instruction cards, affidavits, and other forms which voters may be required to sign and all absentee voting materials shall be printed in both English and Spanish, or Spanish translations thereof and/or other assistance shall be provided, as required by the Texas Election Code and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, each as amended.

Section 6: That notice of said election shall be given by posting a copy thereof, containing a substantial copy of this ordinance at the City Hall and at one other public place within said City not less than fourteen (14) days prior to the date upon which said election is to be held, and by publishing such notice on the same day in each of two (2) consecutive weeks in the Eagle Lake Headlight, the first such publication to be not less than fourteen (14) days prior to the date set for said election. It is hereby found and declared that the Eagle Lake Headlight is a newspaper of general circulation within said City.

Section 7: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon and after its adoption.
