Multi-Area Plan For Brucellosis Control

A new multi-area plan for brucellosis control in Texas is now in effect with new regulations for moving cattle. The new program divides the state into two sections. The Class A area includes about 130 counties in the western part of the state, which is relatively free of brucellosis. The Class B area - which lies east of Class A - consists of counties which have historically had more problems with the disease.

Brucellosis, or Bang's disease, is a highly contagious disease which affects cattle and other animals, as well as humans. In people, it is called undulant fever.

The disease in cattle may cause abortion, weaker calves, lower milk production and sterility. Failure to control the disease could result in more restrictions concerning interstate movement of Texas cattle.

Under the new regulations, all breeding cattle - male and female - 18 months or older will be eligible for testing. Female dairy cattle officially calving vaccinated between three and six months of age would not be tested until they are 30 months old. Female beef cattle vaccinated between three and 10 months of age would be tested until they reach 36 months of age.

One exception to this is that officially vaccinated female females under the ages listed above but which are six or more months pregnant or have a calf by their side would be tested.

Stiers and spayed heifers do not require tests.

Class A Control Area.
The following regulations apply for movement of cattle in Texas.

Persons with test eligible cattle in the Class A control area who want to move them within the area will need a negative test within 30 days prior to movement from a premise to slaughter, quarantine feedlot, or another premise. Cattle may move to market untested but must be tested prior to sale if they have not been tested negative in the previous 30 days.

For ranchers with cattle in Class A areas who want to move them to Class B areas, these regulations apply:

From farm or ranch in Area A to farm, ranch or feedlot in Area B: cattle must be tested negative within 30 days prior to movement and must have an E permit issued by the Texas Animal Health Commission. Hottest at destination is not required.

From Area A farm or ranch to livestock market in Area B: cattle may enter without test or E permit but must be tested prior to sale if cattle are to return to the county, or must be S branded prior to sale if consigned to slaughter or quarantine feedlot.

From farm or ranch in Area A directly to slaughter or quarantine feedlot: cattle may enter without test or E permit but all exposed or affected cattle will be identified and accompanied by an S or B permit, which ever is applicable.

Class B Control Area.
Persons with cattle in Area B who want to move them within Area B, should observe these regulations:

Cattle on a farm or ranch may move to a farm, ranch or feedlot provided they have been tested negative within the previous 30 days.

Cattle on a farm or ranch may move directly to a quarantine feedlot or quarantine pasture. Affected cattle are required to be either S or B branded and accompanied by a B or S permit.
