ORDINANCE NO. 8912

ORDINANCE DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF ARTICLE 1106 V.A.T.C.S. IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED UTILITY SYSTEM TAX BONDS; AND DECLARING THAT SAID ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle Lake, Texas, has adopted Ordinance No. 8911, dated September 30, 1980, calling a bond election to be held in and through out the City of Eagle Lake, Texas, on October 25, 1980, pursuant to and in accordance with the annexed Ordinance adopted by the City Council, said Ordinance being hereby made a part of this Notice for all purposes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto signed my name officially and affixed hereto the seal of the City of Eagle Lake, Texas, this 30th day of September, 1980.

Section 8: That nothing contained in this ordinance shall be deemed to restrict the ability of any City Council to exercise its independent judgment with respect to the best interest of the City; provided, however, no part of the revenues of the Utility System shall be used for any purpose other than that specified in Section 2 hereof unless the sum appropriated to pay the principal of and interest on any Utility Tax Bonds makes it completely unnecessary for the City Council to levy a tax for such purpose.

Section 4: That nothing contained in this ordinance shall be deemed to affect in any manner the covenants of the City as heretofore made in its outstanding revenue bonds which are secured by a pledge of the principal of and interest on the Utility Tax Bonds of any of them are authorized to be issued by the voters of the City; Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE LAKE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the terms defined in the preamble of this ordinance shall be, and are hereby made, a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

Section 2: That each year while any of the Utility Tax Bonds are outstanding and before passing any ordinance levying taxes for that year the City Council will take advantage of the provisions of Article 1106, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, as amended, or any like legislation which may become effective in the future, by setting aside out of the net revenues of the Utility System and applying such sum as the City Council deems to be in the best interest of the City to the payment of the principal of and interest on the Utility Tax Bonds, or any of them that falls due during the following year.

Section 3: That nothing contained in this ordinance shall be deemed to restrict the ability of any City Council to exercise its independent judgment with respect to the best interest of the City; provided, however, no part of the revenues of the Utility System shall be used for any purpose other than that specified in Section 2 hereof unless the sum appropriated to pay the principal of and interest on any Utility Tax Bonds makes it completely unnecessary for the City Council to levy a tax for such purpose.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE LAKE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That an election shall be held in and through out the City of Eagle Lake, Texas, on October 25, 1980, which is not less than fifteen nor more than thirty days from the date of this ordinance, at which election the following proposition shall be submitted to the duly qualified resident electors of said City for their action thereupon, to-wit:

PROPOSITION

SHALL THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLE LAKE, TEXAS, BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE THE TAX BONDS OF SAID CITY, IN ONE OR MORE SERIES OR ISSUES, IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$300,000, MATURING SERIALLY WITHIN 25 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OF ISSUANCE, AND BEARING INTEREST AT A RATE OR RATES PER ANNUM NOT TO EXCEED THE MAXIMUM AUTHORIZED BY LAW AT THE TIME OF ISSUE, ALL AS SHALL BE DETERMINED WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXTENDING AND IMPROVING THE CITY'S EXISTING SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM, AND TO LEVY AN ANNUAL TAX ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN SAID CITY SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE INTEREST - ON SAID BONDS AS IT ACCRUES AND TO CREATE AND PROVIDE A SINKING FUND TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF SAID BONDS AS THEY MATURE.

Section 2: That the entire City shall constitute one election precinct, and said election shall be conducted and held at the Municipal Building, Council Room, located at 100 East Main Street, in the City of Eagle Lake, Texas, and the following named persons are hereby appointed officers to conduct said election, to-wit:

H. E. Tate, Presiding Judge; Mary N. Ballaw, Alternate Presiding Judge.

The Presiding Judge shall appoint as many clerks as he deems necessary for the proper conduct of the election, provided such number of Clerks shall be at least two and not more than four.

Section 3: That election voting shall be conducted by the City Secretary, Miss Lucille Perry, at her regular office in the Municipal Building of the City of Eagle Lake, Texas. The absentee clerk's mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail may be sent is 100 East Main Street, P.O. Box 35, Eagle Lake, Texas 77434. Said City Secretary shall keep said office open for at least eight (8) hours on each day for absentee voting which is not a Saturday, Sunday, or an official State holiday.

Section 4: That voting in said election, including absentee voting, shall be by written or printed ballots which shall conform to the requirements of the Texas Election Code, as amended, and shall have printed thereon the following:

OFFICIAL BALLOT

Place an "X" in the square beside the statement indicating the way you wish to vote.

PROPOSITION

FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$300,000 SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT AND EXTENSION TAX BONDS

AGAINST

Section 5: That all election materials including notice of the election, ballots, instruction cards, affidavits, and other forms which voters may be required to sign and all absentee voting materials shall be printed in both English and Spanish, or Spanish translation thereof, and/or other assistance shall be provided, as required by the Texas Election Code and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.

Section 6: That notice of said election shall be given by posting a copy thereof containing a substantial copy of this ordinance at the City Hall and at one other public place within said City not less than fourteen (14) days prior to the date upon which said election is to be held, and by publishing such notice on the same day in each of two (2) successive weeks in the Eagle Lake Headlight, the first such publication to be not less than fourteen (14) days prior to the date set for said election. It is hereby found and declared that the Eagle Lake Headlight is a newspaper of general circulation within said City.

Section 7: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon and after its adoption.
