Making Progress In Energy Problems, Says Cong. Pickle

[By Cong. J. Pickle] Ever since the Arab embargo of 1973, a common statement has been that we have no national energy policy. Such talk leaves the impression that if we had some kind of simple energy action, we would have plenty of cheap energy. This is just not the case. We're making good strides in getting a handle on our energy consumption problem, on increasing domestic production, and on developing new forms of energy.

For example, conventional recovery techniques leave 60% of the oil in the ground. A new technique called tertiary, which is a process using chemicals and gases to squeeze more oil from the ground, has recovered up to 35 billion more barrels of oil from old oil wells. I have pushed for this method of recovery in Congress, and placed incentives for its use in the Windfall Profits Tax Bill.

Another good achievement was the passage of the Synthetic Fuels Bill. The Synthetic Fuels corporation will not rescue us from OPEC tomorrow, but it sets up several programs for the rest of this century and beyond. With continued impetus from Congress, we are

dent signed into law a bill I co-sponsored which gives a significant boost to fusion energy research and development.

Energy policy is also made through the tax system. Any homeowner can get a credit of up to \$4000 for installing active solar equipment. Other credits encourage insulation and wind energy. In the Ways and Means Committee, we are working on a passive solar tax credit bill. We will soon have a new solar bank to subsidize bank loans for solar improvements. We have also approved the question of business tax breaks to encourage investment in research and production. Americans are also using less energy, and this means less oil is being imported. The collection of taxes on the Middle East supplies are adding the time-tested principle of supply and demand to the decontrol and rising prices have limited demand and expanded production, are making a difference. The Department of Energy says gasoline consumption is down about 7% from last year, and net energy imports are about one-fifth less than 1979.

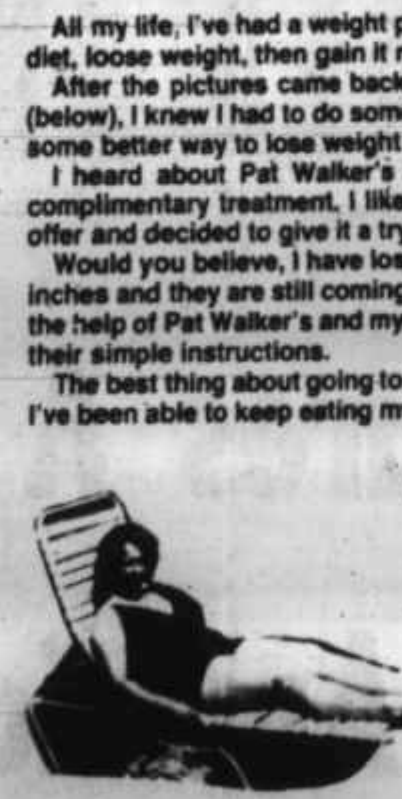
