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Study Club Has Program On Versatility Of Rice

The Eagle Lake Study Club met Wednesday, November 12, in the Conference Room of the Eagle Lake High School Library, with Mrs. Alvin Wiese, president, presiding.

David R. Wintermann gave a short resume on the advances in rice agriculture since 1950. He then introduced Curtis Leonhardt of Houston who is a field representative of the Rice Council.

Since sixty per cent of the rice grown is shipped overseas he is helping to promote the use of rice domestically.

A film was shown showing types of rice grown, such as long grain, short and medium grains and their different uses. Jars with different rices were displayed, even to method at the mill of making the parboiled or Minute Rice.

Rice Consumption Up

In 1950 the average person ate five pounds of rice a year, said Leonhardt. In 1980 it has increased to eight pounds. Inflation has helped the rice industry since women have learned to use rice as an extender for more expensive foods.

A variety of leaflets were offered with recipes for rice. A lady from El Campo had made an attractive centerpiece using silk flowers and rice stalks.

Minutes of the October meeting were read by secretary Mrs. Robert Wilcox and the treasurer's report by Mrs. Elizabeth Boothe.

Every one is happy with the results of the auction held on November 1, and plans for a bigger and better one are being made for 1981. Several items have already been promised.

The meeting ended with Mrs. David Wintermann extending the "library" building since the size of the present building is no longer adequate.
