Farmers' Tax Deadlines Approaching

While most taxpayers have until April 15 to file their 1980 income tax returns, farmers and ranchers face a much earlier filing date.

Agricultural producers who do not file an estimate of their income by Jan. 16 and do not pay estimated taxes must file their tax returns and pay due taxes by March 2.

Dove Season To Re-Open Saturday

Quail are also in season and remain in season through Feb. 15, with a daily bag limit of 12 and possession limit of 36.

The second half of the 1980-81 season on mourning doves in the South Zone of Texas, including this county, opens this Saturday, January 3rd.

The limit on doves is ten per day and possession limit is twenty. Ducks and geese continue in season through Sunday, January 18th.

The limit on ducks continues on the 100-point basis. The possession limit is the number of ducks that would be legal in two days of kill.

Deer Season Ends Sun. Deer season will come to a close this Sunday, January 4th, 1981.

Squirrel remain in season all year long in Colorado County.

Use Of Steel Shot To Be Expanded In '81

The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department reminds waterfowl hunters that the nontoxic steel shot zone now in effect for public hunting areas in one county this season will be expanded significantly for the 1981-82 seasons.

However, during the 1981-82 seasons, hunters will be required to use nontoxic steel shot shells in an area bounded by the Texas-Louisiana state line, from Sabine Pass, Texas, to the mouth of the Brazos River, then south along the east bank of the Brazos to its mouth. The zone extends out in the Gulf of Mexico to the three marine league limit from the mouth of the Brazos and Sabine Pass.

Deer Season Ends Sunday

The 1981 deer hunting season which has been described as fair to poor will close at the end of shooting hours this Sunday, January 4th.

Deer kills have been light and there has been large support for removing the county from state regulatory control in order to stop the killing of deer and also spine backs.

Such action was recommended by the County Commissioners' Court to new State Senator-elect Kent Caperton and State Representative-elect Robert Saunders following a public hearing held on December 8th.

In counties under general law, the season on deer will end December 31st but in this county and surrounding counties under regulatory control, the season ends this Sunday, Jan. 4th.
