Seminar At A&M For Estate Planning

Professionals engaged in estate planning will be briefed on a number of key issues at an upcoming seminar at Texas A&M University. Set for Feb. 23, the sixth Estate Planning Seminar will feature such topics as advantages and disadvantages of incorporating a business, owning and transferring life insurance, gifts to minors, Amendment B regarding separate and community property, income taxation of estates and trusts and special use valuation for farms and ranches.

Special sessions will also be conducted on the Texas Inheritance Tax, valuation of minerals for gifts and estate taxation, tax planning and matters relating to the Internal Revenue Service. A review of current events in estate planning will open the seminar at 9:45 a.m. in the first day, notes Dr. James Ahrens, economist in management with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service, Texas A&M University System, sponsor of the seminar.

Program speakers will include a host of lawyers, a law professor, Internal Revenue Service and life insurance representatives, and bank trust officers. Ahrens notes that of special interest to seminar participants this year will be topics dealing with Amendment 9 passed last Novem-

Peanut Farmers Vote 'Yes' In Referendum Last Dec.

ASCS Lists 1981 Planting Deadlines

The monthly letter of the Colorado County Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service (ASCS) reported that peanut farmers in this county and over the nation voted "yes" in the Peanut Referendum held Dec. 8-11. D. C. Streckfus, county executive director for ASCS, reported in the letter that nationwide the vote was 89.2% for, statewide, 89.3% for; and in Colorado County 18 voted yes and 2 no.

He also listed 1981 planting deadlines. Final dates for planting crops were listed as follows: corn and grain sorghum April 30; cotton, May 15; rice, May 31; soybeans, July 1; and spring peanuts, July 25. He added that cattle should be removed from wheat and barley fields by March 1 if crops in these fields are intended for grain.

January 30th is the final date for wool producers to submit their original sales receipts for wool and/or unshorn lambs if incentive payments are to be earned. The ASCS also advises that if you purchased, sold or in any way changed farming operations, you should notify the county office immediately so that the office records can be updated.
