There will be five students entering the Skills Speed Contest. This portion of the meet consists of four different tests of skill, all of which have a three minute time limit. They include: ignition wiring of a six cylinder Ford inline engine; identifying disc brake parts; installing brake shoes on one wheel of a General Motors car; and installing an intake valve in a 300 V-8 head. **Schneider Received \$1500 Go-Texas Scholarship Tues.**

Rice High School Future Farmers of America students have many entries in the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo youth activities this week.

John Schneider received a \$1500 scholarship at the Colorado County eight activities at the Houston Show at 8 p.m. Tues., March 3rd, in the Astrodom in Houston. He will compete for the \$6000 scholarship when the state FFA meeting is held later this year.

Among the Rice FFA entries in the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo are: 1. A 30-hp. tractor with a check picking machine. 2. A vacuum electric motor steel rod, hospital hose and vacuum cleaner by FFA member Pat Gold. David Seifert will also enter an air compressor, made out of a car motor with plug used for outlets and hooked onto a tractor PTO in the Agricultural Mechanics Project Show.

In Houston Call Scramble Thomas Mahalite and Joe Lang of the Rice chapter competed in the call scramble at 1 p.m. on Sunday, March 1st.

The FFA Chapter will have 12 students with 51 commercial steers in the Houston Show, 2 students with halter steers, two with dairy heifers, five students with hogs and one student will show five chickens.

Commercial Steer Show  
These entries were taken to the Houston Show Tuesday. The commercial steers will be weighed Wednesday and also on that same date at 9 a.m. the commercial steers will be graded and receive ribbons and their owners will take a 30-question written test. Personal interviews will begin and record books will be turned in at 1 p.m.

On Thursday the commercial steers will be sold and at 1 p.m. there will be final interviews and at 6 p.m. that night a banquet will be held at Sonny Look's Sirloin Inn on South Main in Houston when winners of the following prizes will be announced:

First place in the commercial steer competition will receive a pickup truck and \$1000 and a trophy; second place, a gooseneck trailer and \$500 cash; third place, \$250 cash; fourth place, \$150 cash; and fifth place, \$50 cash.
