Get Identification When Cashing Strangers' Check

I would like to again caution our citizens to protect their interest when accepting or cashing a check for anyone. It would be advisable for each merchant to have a stamp made with such information as Name, Address, Date of Birth, Height, Weight, Drivers License Number and Social Security Number. When accepting a check, stamp this information on the back side of the check and write the information in yourself. Especially the Driver's License Number. If the subject cashing the check is unwilling to wait while you obtain this information from him, you may be better off not accepting his check at all. Without a physical description, we are unable to have a warrant served outside of Colorado County. Help us help you by obtaining this information at the time you accept the check.

The increase in federal and state regulations on the health care system has created a greater need for your involvement in legislative affairs. So stated G. Ray Hurst, C.A.B. President of the Texas Hospital Association (THA), an association of hospital administrators at "Auxiliary Day at the Capitol", a program sponsored by the Texas Association of Hospital Auxiliaries (TAHA) and the THA Council on Hospital Auxiliaries. Nearly 200 auxiliaries and directors of volunteer services participated in the two-day program which was highlighted by a visit to the 57th Legislature at the Texas Capitol. Presentations stressed the significance of community input in the legislative system, especially on issues which affect the delivery of health care in Texas.
