TODAY'S MANUFACTURED HOMES

SOLID SUPPORT
 Construction of manufactured homes begins with the heavy steel permanent chassis. Cross members and "outriggers" are welded to the two I-beams providing solid support for the entire house. The size of the steel components in the chassis is determined by the engineering design of the particular home, so that the permanent chassis becomes an integral part of the support system of the home.

The completed chassis, with axles and wheels attached, is hoisted onto the sub-floor frame and fastened securely with lag bolts. The chassis and sub-floor assembly are then righted for movement to the next construction station. Techniques may vary from plant to plant to make the required assembly.

Following the joining of the chassis and sub-floor assembly, the flooring of the home is attached using materials that meet the engineering specifications approved by the design approval inspection agencies.
