Humid weather is expected through Wednesday as highs reach near 88 degrees. Winds picked up from the south Tuesday as a Pacific cool front moved. Fair, warm days and mild nights are in store Thursday through Saturday. Rain chances will remain low throughout the period.

For the Rice Belt cool morning temperatures last weekend may have caused some cold shock in rice seedlings. Symptoms are pale green color of leaves and slow leaf development. During periods of cold injury, herbicide applications should be avoided if possible to prevent excessive burn to the rice seedlings. Temperatures may be on the cool side again Thursday morning but warmer weather going into the weekend should allow better recovery from cold injury.

For the Coastal Bend crops should continue to take excellent growth this week as sunshine remains abundant. Growers should keep an eye on pest activity during this spring weather. Greenbugs and yellow sugarcane aphids may become problems in their rapid development. Outcrops were reported in some cotton fields. However beneficial insect activity is at a very good level in most of the cotton in the area. Winds will likely be too strong for safe pesticides spraying through Wednesday. Cotton bolls should come Thursday.

NOTICE TO RICE CONSOLIDATED L.S.D. TAXPAYERS
The Rice Consolidated L.S.D. has contracted with an attorney at law for his services to collect past due delinquent accounts.

Penalty and interest is owed on delinquent accounts at this time and will be charged if paid now. On May 1, 1981, delinquent accounts will be given to the attorney for collection. An additional fifteen (15%) percent attorney's fee will be charged to the taxpayer for any accounts collected which have been turned over to the attorney.

After June 1, 1981, suits will be filed on delinquent accounts. Court costs, in addition to penalty and interest and 15% legal fee, will be added to accounts collected through court.

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
