An upper air disturbance will increase showers in the Coastal Plains with the best chance for rain on Wednesday. As the weather pattern slowly shifts, rain chances will decrease again Thursday through Saturday. A few heavy rain amounts may occur Wednesday afternoon. Temperatures will cling very little from day to day.

In the Rice Belt rice fields have another chance to get needed rain during the next couple of days, especially Wednesday. Following the rain, cloudiness should decrease and some abundant sunshine is expected for the weekend. Some extended delays of field work may occur where thunderstorms become slow-moving or heavy. Growers should try to complete spray applications as early as possible Tuesday to avoid wash-off and delays. Other field work should reach a convenient stopping point Tuesday in case delays occur Wednesday.

In the Coastal Bend some rains may reach the Coastal Bend by Wednesday and could benefit young crops. After mid-week, however, prospects for more rain will decrease and more sunshine is anticipated. Some field work delays are possible on Wednesday afternoon. Chemical applications may run into some wash-off problems the next couple of days especially during the afternoon.

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Federal Land Bank Reps. Attend State Meeting

H. P. Donigan of Pattison, has just returned from Houston where he represented The Federal Land Bank Association of Bellville at the 26th Annual Stockholders Meeting of The Federal Land Bank of Texas. The meeting, held at the Houston Oaks Hotel, was attended by members of 60 Federal Land Bank Associations in Texas.

Thomas H. Benson, president, in his report to the stockholders, stated that there was an increasing demand for new loans in 1980. This was the second largest year of loans closed in

the Bank's history, with 3,774 loans closed for a total of \$322.3 million. This compares to 1979 figures of 3,990 loans closed, for a total of \$387.8 million.

The Federal Land Bank of Texas makes long-term loans on farms, ranches and rural residences and currently has \$7,500 loans for approximately \$11.8 billion outstanding.

The Federal Land Bank Association of Bellville makes and services loans in this area. Members of the board of directors are Cecil Rockwood of Katy, E. F. Borgstede of Washington, Borgestede of Sheridan, J. P. Donigan of Pattison and J. J. Elick of Bellville.

Others attending the meeting from this area were Manager and Mrs. Clifton Mahon and Mr. and Mrs. J. J. Elick.

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
