Twenty high school students from across the state have won prizes in the "55 for Texas" editorial contest. Senior student Bert Tise claimed victory in the District III Education Service Center area.

The 20 winners were chosen by local high school English and Journalism teachers from 125 participating schools to represent each of the 20 Education Service Center districts in the state. Regional winners were then judged by a team of capital press corps reporters employed by the Houston Chronicle, Dallas Times Herald, and Austin American Statesman.

Tise Wins 3rd In State Ready Writing Contest

Bert Tise received the State bronze medal in Ready Writing Friday, May 8, in Austin. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Sammy Tise of Eagle Lake and Sublime.
