Foreign Investors have reported owning 685,793 acres of Texas farmland, according to a report from the U. S. Department of Agriculture.

The figure is based on reports filed by foreign groups as of last December under the Agricultural Foreign Investment Disclosure Act of 1978.

USDA officials say Foreign Agricultural Land Holdings were reported in all states except Rhode Island, Maine.
