Last Memorial Day in Austin, Myrza Montoya thought so. After watching Shovel Creek steadily rise towards her house, she realized that she would have to evacuate. Her home was on Jefferson Street, and now half of it is gone. The back half of the house plus all of her possessions have been relocated somewhere downstream. Myrza was lucky in that she left in time and escaped; two of her neighbors did not.

Neither Myrza nor the owner of the house had flood insurance, although the house was in the floodplain and had suffered minor flooding before. Myrza said she was not aware that insurance was available to people who rent their homes, although insurance is available to renters for their household property up to the amount of \$10,000 coverage. Myrza is not alone in her belief. Initial telephone research of 50 contacts in Austin reveals that most people do not know that flood insurance is available, in ad-

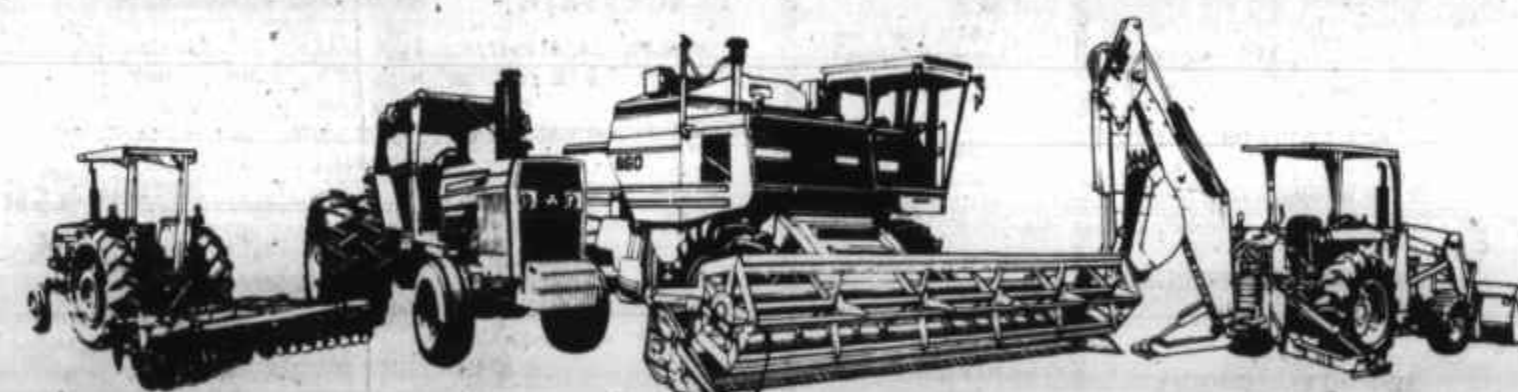
